

## CO-ORDINATING CONJUNCTION

### 'and'

- A main clause is a sentence that makes sense on its own
- Co-ordinating conjunctions are words that join two main clauses to make one sentence

**You like eating apples.**  
(main clause 1)

**You like eating bananas.**  
(main clause 2)

- 'and' is used when both clauses are linked and show similar ideas

**You like eating apples and you like eating bananas.**
