Lower case print format

Video from 'ABC kindergarten' showing how to form all 26 **lower case** letters of the alphabet in **print format** on one continuous video

In this video some of the letters (h, i, l, m, n and t) are given a small joining curve. The 'teachhandwriting' print formations do not have these joining curves but the cursive print formations do.

Upper case print format

There are a few differences in how letters (G, I, J, T and U) are formed between this video and 'teachhandwriting'. I would recommend using the 'teachhandwriting' formations where there are differences.
