

## PRESENT TENSE (simple)

- Verbs are doing words
- In the present simple tense I, you, we and they have the same verb form
- He, she and it add an 's' or an 'es' to the verb

### Read these examples

1) verb - eat / eats

Everyday I eat my lunch.

Everyday he eats his lunch.

2) verb - sees / see

Everyday you see your teacher.

Everyday she sees her teacher.

3) verb - plays / play

Everyday we play five games of chess.

Everyday he plays five games of chess.

4) verb - wait / waits

Everyday they wait for a parcel to arrive.

Everyday she waits for a parcel to arrive

5) verb - visits / visit

Everyday I visit the museum.

Everyday he visits the museum.

Everyday it rains.
