

## SUBJECT NOUNS

- A noun is the name of a person, place or thing
- A proper noun is a specific name for a noun
- A subject noun is the noun that performs the action of a sentence -  
'The boy kicked the ball' (boy is the subject noun because the boy is doing the kicking)
